

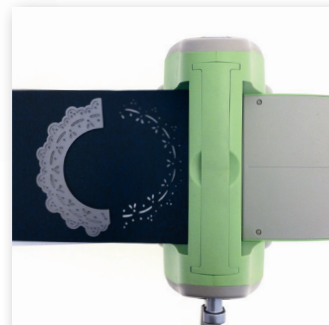
# How to use the *Tilda Doily* Doohickey



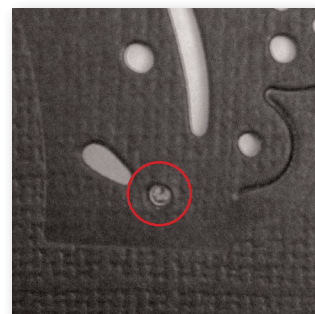
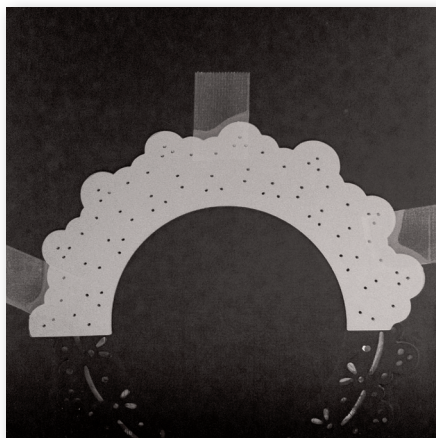
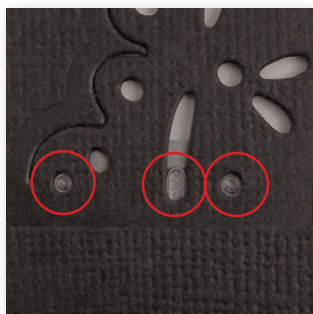
1. The materials you need. We have used the Cuttlebug, a black cardstock and the Tilda Doily.



2. Make the first cut by pressing the die against the paper using the Cuttlebug.



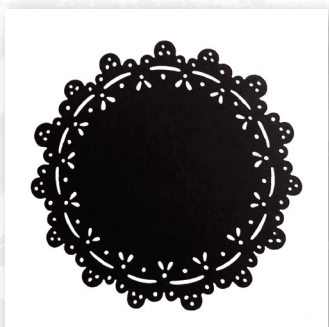
3. When you have made the first cut, TURN THE PAPER OVER and align the die with the first cut to make a whole circle shaped figure.



4. When you align the die to the first cut, make sure that 4 of the cutting edges from the die are visible in the already cut holes of the paper (see images above). When you have aligned the die, use some tape to make sure that it doesn't move when you run it through the machine the second time.



5. Repeat the second step to cut out the whole circle.



6. All done!
